Gap Year Expo:


Not sure what you want to do after grad? Would you love the opportunity to travel, build your resume, or start a business before university, but not sure how to take the first step?

- if an athlete has coexisting and/or confounding factors that may or may not reflect ongoing
 physiological injury to the brain (e.g., neck injury, oculovestibular injury, exercise intolerance,
 anxiety, depression, etc.), the consulting physician may recommend targeted management
 strategies to specifically address the primary and secondary factors contributing to their
 symptoms (e.g., neck rehab, vestibular therapy, vision therapy, exercise prescription,
 psychology services, etc.).
 - many of these rehabilitation services are <u>not covered</u> under basic Alberta Healthcare Service plans, nor the BCI Subscription Program, and thus additional costs may apply if the athlete / family chooses to utilize such services.
