- Our insight tells us that no two athletes are the same. BCI's pre-season baseline multi-modal
 neurologic assessment fosters a *precision medicine* paradigm by assisting our clinical team to tailor

- If an acute sport-related concussion or other sport-related injury is suspected/sustained, your athlete (or parent/team therapist/coach) merely calls the BCI Performance Medicine Clinic where they will be triaged and expeditiously booked to see a Sport Medicine Physician. Athletes will be comprehensively assessed, managed, and followed regularly in clinic through recovery and return to sport.

- if an athlete has coexisting and/or confounding factors that may or may not reflect ongoing physiological injury to the brain (e.g., neck injury, oculovestibular injury, exercise intolerance, anxiety, depression, etc.), the consulting physician may recommend targeted management strategies to specifically address the primary and secondary factors contributing to their symptoms (e.g., neck rehab, vestibular therapy, vision therapy, exercise prescription, psychology services, etc.).
 - many of these rehabilitation services are <u>not covered</u> under basic Alberta Healthcare Service plans, nor the BCI Subscription Program, and thus additional costs may apply if the athlete / family chooses to utilize such services.


